RELEASE AND RECORDING ASSIGNMENT

(the GNAS), other participants, sponsors, advertisers, organizations associated with the GNAS, volunteers, and their respective officers, agents, and employees, from any and every claim, damage, cost, or cause of action which may be sustained or incurred by a participant in connection with the Nature Festival, including death, permanent paralysis, other personal injury or property damage of known or unknown origin, even if caused by a releasee intentionally or through negligence.

The undersigned further grants full permission to the GNAS and those it authorizes to use any photographs, videos, audio recordings or any other record of participants for any purpose, including profit. The GNAS reserves the right to restrict or remove any participant which its official in his sole discretion deems inappropriate.
